**TO: ALL PERSONNEL**

**I. POLICY**

Prior to assuming the duties of a sworn police officer, or community service officer, all such employees shall be required to take an oath of office. The oath shall be administered and signed by the Chief of Police. The officer shall also be required to sign. Both signatures will be notarized at which time the oath shall be placed in the officer's personnel file.

The oath requires the officer to swear and affirm to support and defend the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of the State of Colorado, the Craig City Charter and Ordinances, and to faithfully discharge the duties of a Craig Police Officer.

All personnel hired will be required to take and acknowledge by signature the Law Enforcement Code of Honor.
