I. POLICY

It is generally the policy of this Department to refer wildlife violations to the Colorado Department of Wildlife. If Division of Wildlife Officers are not available Officers are responsible for the enforcement of wildlife violations within the City of Craig as provided by Title 33 of the Colorado Revised Statutes Investigation of wildlife violations can be conducted as part of a traffic contact or as a dispatched call.

II. PROCEDURE

A. Whenever an officer suspects a violation of Title 33 has occurred, they will conduct an investigation into the suspected crime. If a violation is detected, the officer will either make an arrest or issue a Penalty Assessment Ticket, whichever is appropriate.
